Opportunity Corridor 3 (OC3) is the third and final project making the final connection of the brand new 5-lane corridor connecting I-490 to E. 105th Street in an effort to provide an improved connection to the University Circle area and open the area for the potential economic development and new jobs. The OC3 project, which was a design-build project, completes approximately 2 miles of new boulevard from I-490 to E. 89th Street and includes 6 new bridges, 12 retaining walls, 7 new intersections and numerous improvements to the drainage and combined sewer system. ELR, a major design sub-consultant on the project, provided on-site utility/railroad/third party coordination, bridge and wall design services, geotechnical design and hydraulics design support.
