E.L. Robinson Engineering (ELR) was selected by the City of Logan and The WVDOH to develop construction plans for streetscape improvements along both sides of Stratton Street in downtown Logan. ELR prepared the streetscape design for Stratton Street from Dingess Street to Washington Street based on the previously constructed design of the WVDHHR Building at Cole Street, utilizing matching materials and construction methods, including new brick pavers for the project area.

The design also improved the curbing throughout the project area to attain a 3" minimum to 6" maximum curb height where possible; placed PVC conduit underground for future street lighting; identified the underground vaults and basements in the sidewalk and designed for new sidewalk construction at those locations; and upgraded the crosswalks to meet current ADA and DOH standards.
