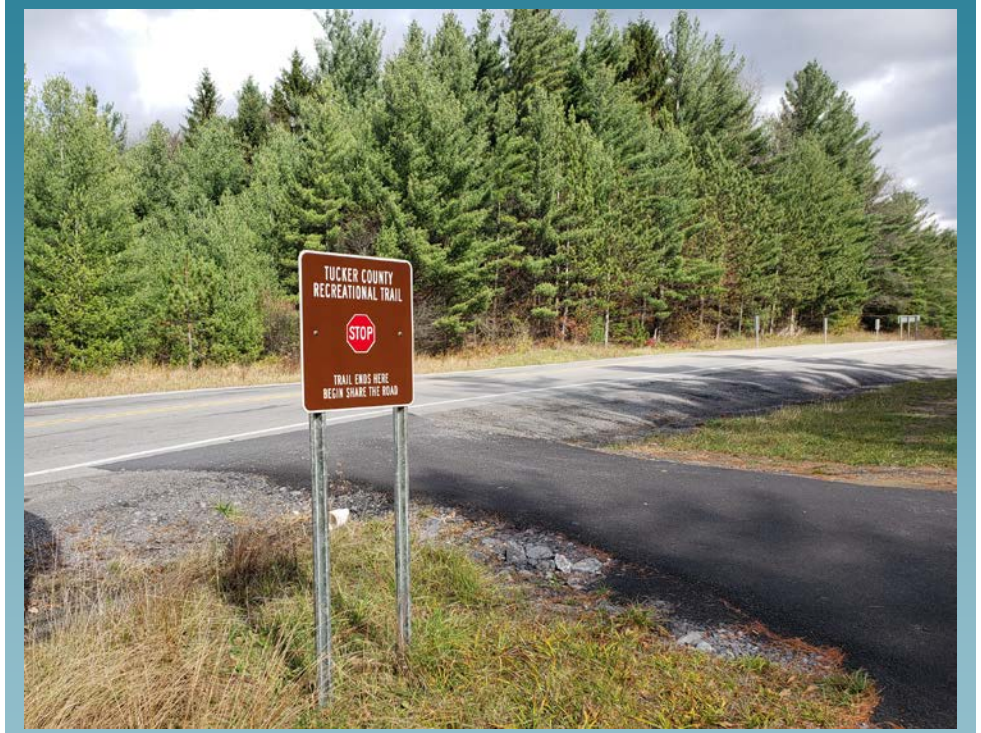

The Tucker County Foundation received a WVDOH Recreational Trails grant combined with their share for \$150,000 for the planning and design of a trailhead and new trail segment. The trail and trailhead construction is in the 0.22-acre tract at the Town of Davis' Public Tucker County Rocks! Park, adjacent to WV32. The development of the trailhead included a gravel parking area for 20-25 cars, trail wayfinding kiosk, trail directional signage, bicycle rack, trash receptacle and landscaping. The trail development included a connector trail from the intersection of WV 93 & WV 32 to the community park along WV 93 on WVDOH right of way and/or Western Pocahontas Property easement conveyed to the Town of Davis' Public Park property.
